We are Learning!

Reading: This week we started our new reading series. This first unit focuses on Places to Go. Each week I will be sending home the workbook pages we did throughout the week. Please be aware that some of the pages are empty. Some of the pages we will just be discussing and not writing things down on them. We are working real hard on phonetically sounding out our words. Some of the children are really struggling with this but we will keep practicing throughout the year. This week we added three more word pocket words to our list. They are: go, three and four. Please remember to keep practicing the word pocket words each day. Some children are needing a lot more practice with these words that can't be sounded out.

Math: In math we are working on writing and recognizing our numbers. The tricky teens are especially hard for many of the kindergarteners. We learned a new game called "Monster Squeeze" which is on the back of this newsletter too. We also were introduced to attribute blocks and the calculator.

Religion: This week we talked Saints. We learned about many different Saints and how we can be more like them.
