## What We Did This Week

### Religion

In Religion we have been talking about God welcoming us into his family and how we can welcome others by being nice to others, sharing, helping them and talking with them. We have a very welcoming class this year and have made everyone feel comfortable in our new kindergarten environment.

### Reading

This week we learned three more words for our word pockets: *we, green and red*. The kindergarteners will be learning over 90 words this year. We read stories about the color red and made Clifford, the big, red, dog. We learned a songs to help us remember how to spell red and green. (We will be learning songs for all our color words.) We are really working on recognizing our upper and lowercase letters and are starting to learn the sounds each letter makes. We have started focusing on a letter each day and this week we learned the letters li, Tt, Ll and Oo. The children love making their "animal alphabet", and learning the sound for each letter and learning to write the corresponding lowercase and uppercase letters correctly.

### Math

Our math series is filled with lots of hands-on activities for the children. As a result of having such a hands-on curriculum focus, you will probably be seeing very few worksheets coming home from math. I do always include a home-connection math activity on the back of my newsletters that you can do at home with your child to review the skills taught that week. This week we focused on numbers, sorting and counting.
